- 1. Take Hwy 237 East exit toward Alviso/Milpitas
- 2. Take the Zanker Road exit

- 4. Zanker Road becomes Los Esteros Road
- 5. End at 700 Los Esteros Road, San Jose
- From Hwy 880 southbound:

- 1. Take Hwy 237 West Alviso Milpitas Road toward Mountain View
- 2. Take the Zanker Road exit
- 3. Turn RIGHT onto Zanker Road
- 4. Zanker Road becomes Los Esteros Road
- 5. End at 700 Los Esteros Road in San Jose
